### LITURGY OF THE WORD

#### FIRST READING:

**Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15**

The whole community of the sons of Israel began to complain against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness and said to them, 'Why did we not die at the Lord's hand in the land of Egypt, when we were able to sit down to pans of meat and could eat bread to our heart's content! As it is, you have brought us to this wilderness to starve this whole company to death!' Then the Lord said to Moses, 'Now I will rain down bread for you from the heavens. Each day the people are to go out and gather the day's portion; I propose to test them in this way to see whether they will follow my law or not.' 'I have heard the complaints of the sons of Israel. Say this to them, "Between the two evenings you shall eat meat, and in the morning you shall have bread to your heart's content. Then you will learn that I, the Lord, am your God.'" And so it came about: quails flew up in the evening, and they covered the camp; in the morning there was a coating of dew all round the camp. When the coating of dew lifted, there on the surface of the desert was a thing delicate, powdery, as fine as hoarfrost on the ground. When they saw this, the sons of Israel said to one another, 'What is that?' not knowing what it was. 'That' said Moses to them 'is the bread the Lord gives you to eat.'

#### RESPONSORIAL PSALM

Your mind must be renewed by a spiritual revolution so that you can put on the new self that has been created in God's way, in the goodness and holiness of the truth. **The Word of the Lord**

**Mt 4:4**

**Alléluia, alléluia!** No one lives on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God. **Alléluia!**

#### GOSPEL:

**John 6:24-35**

When the people saw that neither Jesus nor his disciples were there, they got into boats and crossed to Capernaum to look for Jesus. When they found him on the other side, they said to him, 'Rabbi, when did you come here?' Jesus answered: 'I tell you most solemnly, you are not looking for me because you have seen the signs but because you had all the bread you wanted to eat. Do not work for food that cannot last, but work for food that endures to eternal life, the kind of food the Son of Man is offering you, for on him the Father, God himself, has set his seal.' Then they said to him, 'What must we do if we are to do the works that God wants?' Jesus gave them this answer, 'This is working for God: you must believe in the one he has sent.' So they said, 'What sign will you give to show us that we should believe in you? What work will you do? Our fathers had manna to eat in the desert; as scripture says: He gave them bread from heaven to eat.' Jesus answered: 'I tell you solemnly, it was not Moses who gave you bread from heaven, it is my Father who gives you the bread from heaven, the true bread; for the bread of God is that which comes down from heaven and gives life to the world.' 'Sir,' they said 'give us that bread always.' Jesus answered: 'I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never be hungry; he who believes in me will never thirst.'

## GREEK / HEBREW WORD

### Bread

**Greek “ἄρτον” (arton)**

**Hebrew “לחם”(lehem)**

Along with physical hunger man has within him another hunger, a more basic hunger, which cannot be satisfied by ordinary food. It is *a hunger for life, a hunger for eternity*. The sign of the manna was the proclamation of the coming of Christ who was to satisfy man's hunger for eternity by himself becoming the "living bread" which "gives life to the world". And see: those who heard Jesus ask him to fulfil what had been proclaimed by the sign of the manna, perhaps without being conscious of how far their request would go: "*Lord, give us this bread always*" (Jn 6:34). How eloquent is this request! How generous and how amazing is its fulfilment. "*I am the bread of life*; he who comes to me shall not hunger, and he who believes in me shall never thirst... For my flesh is food indeed, and my blood is drink indeed. He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me, and I in him" (Jn 6:35,55-56). "*He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day*" (Jn 6:54).

*What a great dignity has been bestowed on us!* The Son of God gives himself to us in the Most Holy Sacrament of his Body and Blood. *How infinitely great is God's generosity!* He responds to our deepest desires, which are not only desires for earthly bread, but extend to the horizons of life eternal. This is the great mystery of faith!

# LITURGIA DELLA PAROLA

## PRIMA LETTURA

Es 16,2-4.12-15

In quei giorni, nel deserto tutta la comunità degli Israeliti mormorò contro Mosè e contro Aronne. Gli Israeliti dissero loro: «Fossimo morti per mano del Signore nella terra d'Egitto, quando eravamo seduti presso la pentola della carne, mangiando pane a sazietà! Invece ci avete fatto uscire in questo deserto per far morire di fame tutta questa moltitudine». Allora il Signore disse a Mosè: «Ecco, io sto per far piovere pane dal cielo per voi: il popolo uscirà a raccoglierne ogni giorno la razione di un giorno, perché io lo metta alla prova, per vedere se cammina o no secondo la mia legge. Ho inteso la mormorazione degli Israeliti. Parla loro così: "Al tramonto mangerete carne e alla mattina vi sazierete di pane; saprete che io sono il Signore, vostro Dio"». La sera le quaglie salirono e coprirono l'accampamento; al mattino c'era uno strato di rugiada intorno all'accampamento. Quando lo strato di rugiada svanì, ecco, sulla superficie del deserto c'era una cosa fine e granulosa, minuta come è la brina sulla terra. Gli Israeliti la videro e si dissero l'un l'altro: «Che cos'è?», perché non sapevano che cosa fosse. Mosè disse loro: «È il pane che il Signore vi ha dato in cibo».

Gv 6,24-35
